Repairing The Breach (RTB)

Provides programs to enlighten, empower and equip un-churched youth in the Alcy/Ball Community spiritually, socially, and academically.

An exciting event where each individual or team plays 100 holes of golf in a day. (Team members combine for the 100 holes, playing only one at a time.)

Each golfer finds enough sponsors to raise \$1,000. Teams (of 2-4) must raise a total of \$2,000. After that, the golfer arrives at dawn...eats breakfast, plays golf, eats lunch, wins prizes, plays more golf, eats dinner, and wins more prizes and go home after dark.
